♦ 1. Fragmented Access to Funding

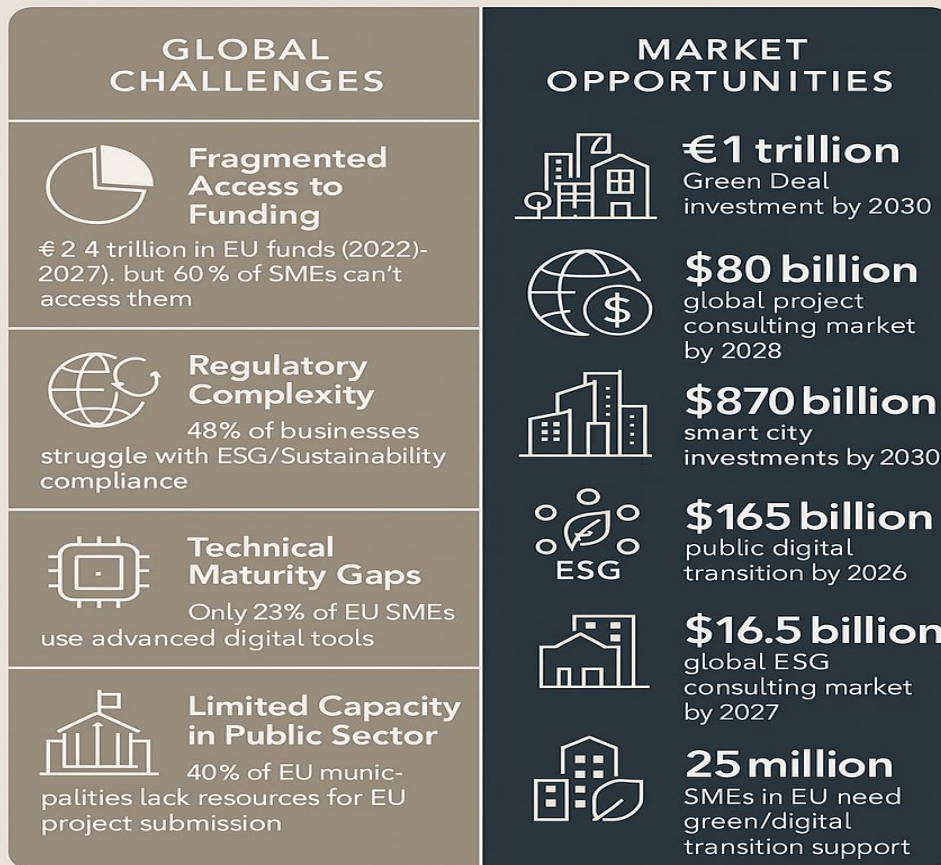

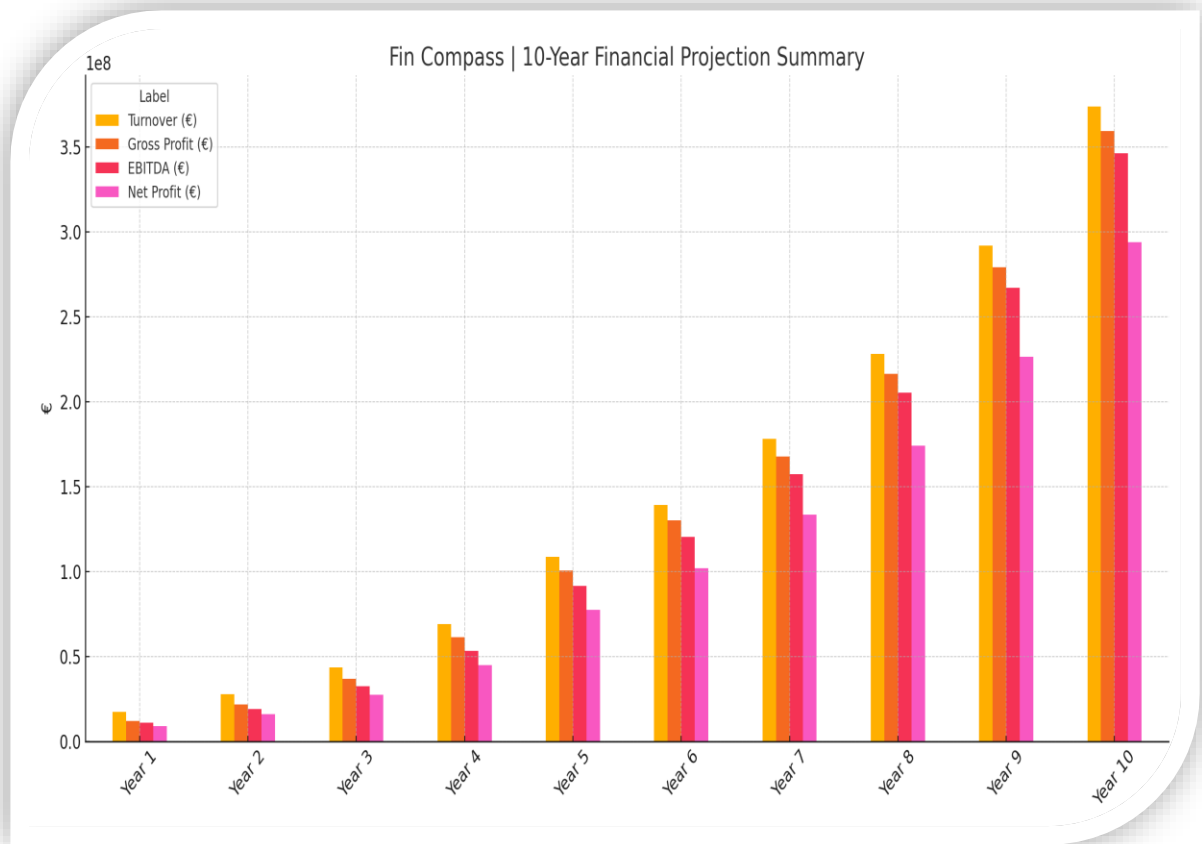
